

2018 - 2019 Overview



Keep doing what we love.

At CSSA, we have worked tirelessly to write stories in the chapter of spreading of Chinese culture around the world. In the past year, we have planned a number of amazing events, such as the National Day flag-raising ceremony, the Chinese Spring Festival Gala, the Wandering Earth film screening and informative lectures. Thanks to the growing influence, the Association will have more resources to organize even better events!

The Spring Festival Gala held this year has had a wide–ranging influence on campus and has been well commented by school teachers. Organizing events at the school gymnasium allowed us to escape the restrictions of the school agreement with Aramark, which resulted in savings in spending on the Spring Festival Gala and eventually resulted in more acceptable ticket price.

In early March 2019, CSSA successfully held the election of the new president and ministers. Adopting innovative election methods has enabled the voting rate to reach 13%. In this election, Guo Tiancheng was elected to be the President. The new CSSA president and department leaders will continue to spread Chinese culture around the world under the supervision of the President Bureau, and strictly follow the requirements and rules of Thompson Rivers University and Student Union.

Election Report

Chinese Students & Scholars Association hosted its annual election for the 2019 to 2020 academic year.

The election is in accordance with the CSSA Club Regulation and Constitution, which was approved by Huang Longtian, Cai Xinran, Shu Fengru, Wang Yiying, Zhang Qi, Deng Haonan on September 1st, 2018.

The current Human Resources Committee formed Election Committee to supervise the duration of the election. The election conference was hosted on March 7th, 2019 at 7:00 PM and was live streaming through CSSA Youtube Channel.

Deng Haonan, was appointed by the Election Committee to lead the conference.

2019 Election Key Data

After a 48-hour voting period, we have completed the election of the President, Secretary, the Minister of Culture and Entertainment, the Minister of Finance, and the Minister of Human Resources. The total number of Chinese students studying at Thomson River University is about 600. The total number of participants in the election is 80, and the number of abstentions is 0. The participation rate is 13%, which is 6.2% higher than last year, and the abstention ratio is 0%.





Department of Entertainment

In the summer of 2018, the Entertainment Department, as the event planning department of CSSA, aims to enrich the life of TRU students, while carrying the educational significance of promoting Chinese culture and spreading traditional Chinese cultures around the world.

The main job of the Entertainment Department is to create, plan and operate the activities we carry out.

In 2018, we launched the flag-raising ceremony on the theme of celebrating the 69th National Day of China.

The TRU 2019 Spring Festival Evening, held by the Chinese Students and Scholars Association at Thomson River University on February 7th, was successfully completed with the active participation of the students.

Nearly 200 people participated in the Spring Festival Gala, and TRU President Brett Fairbairn attended the event with his wife and Baihua Chadwick (CEO TRU World Global Operations).

The event has had a wide-ranging impact on campus, and students from all countries have actively and enthusiastically participated in various activities. It has greatly promoted the spread of Chinese culture to the world and promoted the exchange and collision between Chinese culture and cultures from the world.

Department of Secretary

During the working hours of the Secretarial Department, all members of our department adhere to the purpose of the CSSA "Serving Chinese Students" and its development direction, and strive to do all kinds of work and carry out various activities.

In the future work, the Secretarial Department continues to deepen the awareness of serving the students wholeheartedly, with the courage to take responsibility, and complete the task on time. The summary is as follows:

Regular Work

1. Coordination

The Secretarial Department is an important part of the CSSA and is directly led and accountable to the CSSA President Bureau. At the same time, the secretary department is responsible for coordination and communication between various departments. Its main tasks are: assisting the President's work, preparing for each large—scale event; communicating the decision—making of the activity to the ministries in a timely manner, allocating the work of each ministry, and timely reflecting and reporting the situation of each department. Help the Bureau to coordinate the tasks of the various departments in the event, in order to prepare the Bureau for timely adjustments.

In the first semester, our department has completed the following important tasks, including coordinating the rental of venues and audio; the pre-sale fare of the Spring Festival Evening, and other departments to carry out the deployment of assistance personnel to ensure the smooth development of the CSSA.

2. Keeping Files

One of the basic functions of the Secretarial Department is responsible for the work of the CSSA's regular meeting minutes, activity summary, information summary, etc., to keep abreast of the work status and activities of various departments, and to reflect the work situation to the Bureau in a timely manner.

- (1) Do a good job in archiving files. Mainly to do a good meeting minutes of each regular meeting, and sorted into the file. Prepare the work schedule for next week in advance, and the words spoken by each meeting person can be traced.
- (2) Regularly organize CSSA assets. Ensure the expenditure and warehousing assessment, and make a record of the expenses and lending of the items belonging to the CSSA in each department.
- (3) Collect various documents of various departments. The planning documents, application documents, and work summary documents of each department's activities shall be regularly summarized, and the awards will be collected in various activities and archived.

3. Financial management.

Funding for the activities of the CSSA is managed by the Secretariat and reimbursed for the preparation funds for each activity. Control the expenditure of funds, so that the money can be used where it is necessary to prevent waste in any department. The responsibility of the material manager is to collect all kinds of items and tools needed for each activity, register and manage the entry and exit of materials, and check the inventory content at any time to ensure timely response to the material needs of various departments.

During the preparation period of the event, because the purchase is not complete, the material manager needs to remedy in time to carry out the second purchase. As a qualified material manager, you should carefully and carefully remember the materials needed by other departments and prepare in advance.

4. Assist the work of other departments.

Assist other departments to modify the event plan, propose suggestions and opinions, and make the event more perfect, rich and close to the life of Chinese students.

Activity work

- 1. The work schedule of this week will be summarized on time every Thursday, and uploaded as a computer file. At the same time, the meeting minutes will be recorded and archived.
- 2. When students have large and small activities, such as National Day flag raising, ice-breaking ceremony and Spring Festival Gala, cooperate with and help each department to maintain order and coordinate work.
- 3. Discuss with the Ministry of Human Resources the pre-sale fare for the Spring Festival Evening, and assist the Department of Entertainment in the part of the promotion of the Spring Festival Gala.

In the past semester, the work of the Secretarial Department has both outstanding and inadequacies.

On the basis of summing up the experience, we will make timely improvements, improve the capabilities of all aspects, and make the work of the Secretarial Department better.

In the new semester, we will continue to work hard to achieve better results, and work with all departments to build a better tomorrow for the CSSA.

A message from the Accountant

Hello everyone, my name is Mi Lan and I am in charge of recording financial expenditure for Chinese Students & Scholars Association at Thompson Rivers University. The following is my financial report for the academic year from 2018 to 2019.

First of all, our profit is divided into three parts, the tickets for the Spring Festival Gala, cash, and sponsorship fees from major institutions, a total income of 11786.8CAD.

By the start of the Spring Festival on February 1, 2019, we sold tickets for the Spring Festival Gala totaling 1151.3 CAD. A total of 835.5CAD in cash. The Student Union receives a total of 9800 CAD sponsorship fees, and the institutions it provides are:

Combined with the remaining 3835.31 CAD of the student union of the previous school year and the profit of 4108.46 CAD for the current academic year, a total of 7743.37 CAD is left.
